Holiday Leftover Casserole

What You Need

- (6 oz.) of leftover stuffing
- 4 cups chopped leftover roasted turkey
- 2 cups frozen mixed vegetables (carrots, corn, green beans, peas), thawed
- 3/4 cup KRAFT Real Mayo Mayonnaise or MIRACLE WHIP Dressing
- 3 cups leftover mashed potatoes
- 1 cup KRAFT Shredded Cheddar Cheese
- 1/8 tsp. Paprika

Make It

HEAT oven to 375°F.

SPREAD stuffing onto bottom of 13x9-inch baking dish sprayed with cooking spray.

COMBINE turkey, mixed vegetables and mayo; spoon over stuffing.

MIX potatoes and cheese; spread over turkey mixture. Sprinkle with paprika.

BAKE 30 to 40 min. or until heated through.

You can also....

- Substitute 3 cups leftover prepared homemade stuffing for the prepared STOVE TOP Stuffing
- Prepare using KRAFT Light Mayo Reduced Fat Mayonnaise and KRAFT 2% Milk Shredded Cheddar Cheese.
- Substitute chopped leftover roasted turkey for cooked ground turkey.

D.I.Y Snowmen Christmas Ornament



What you need

- Ornament
- White hanging ribbon
- Paint
- Black marker
- Orange crayon chunk or paint

Wash your hand well and then cover the inside of your fingers with paint. Hold the ornament and press three fingers firmly across the face of it. Push each finger down and roll them to make sure that the entire finger showed up.



Your ornament should look something like this



Once the paint is dry, you will want to add eyes, mouths and buttons to your snowmen.

To do this take a black marker and place black dots for the eyes, in the shape of a smile and for the buttons.

Then draw on a small triangle for the nose. You can now add hats, scarves and more – be creative! Add the white ribbon and your ornament is ready to hang on your tree!
